

# DINO-X Rules

For 1 to 4 players  
Ages 8 and up

## Contents

DVD, 4 dinosaur skeletons (each one is made up of 10 parts), 4 dinosaur construction cards, 44 game cards, stickers.

## Setup

Place all skeleton parts in the center of the playing area. Each player takes a dinosaur construction card. This is the dinosaur that you will have to put together to win. Choose one player to be the game leader. That player will operate the DVD remote control throughout the game.

Turn on the DVD-player, load the DVD into the DVD-player and set the TV to the DVD-channel. After a short introduction you will see the main menu on the screen.

The "listening question". Listen carefully to what is being asked.

The "seeing question". Look carefully at the film or photo.

The "knowledge question". The most difficult question, that cannot be answered from what you see or hear.

**There are three types of questions**

## Playing

The youngest player starts the game, then play moves to the left. The game leader chooses "Play" in the main menu then selects **OK/Enter** to get the first random question.

The player whose turn it is should carefully listen and watch the video clip, drawing or photograph. You will be asked a question at random about it.

You can clearly see what type of question you'll get before the question starts.

Pay careful attention to the video clip, drawing or photo that you are shown. You will be asked a random question about it.

### ANSWERING:

After you are given the three choices to your question, take a few moments to think about what your answer is. When you're ready, announce your answer out loud to the game leader, saying "A", "B" or "C". The game leader uses the arrow keys on the remote control to select that letter and presses "OK".

You will now find out whether your answer was right or wrong. There's also a short explanation provided for extra fun and learning.

If you have answered the question correctly, you can take one skeleton part that you need for your dinosaur.

Whether you answer correctly or not, the player to the left now takes their turn.

### ENDING AND WINNING THE GAME:

The first person to collect all 10 parts to their dinosaur wins.

### Tip:

If you want to skip a question for any reason you can use the 'MENU'-button on the remote control.

**Note:** This DVD is formatted to work on as many DVD players as possible. However as with any software product, it is not possible to create a disc that will be compatible with every DVD player.

## Option: Playing with Game Cards:

For a longer game, use the game cards provided in the set. This option lets players challenge each other to try to make their opponents lose skeleton parts.

Shuffle the cards and place them face down near the skeleton parts.

Play is the same as the regular game but in addition, every time you answer a question (correctly or incorrectly) take the top card from the deck. Don't show it!

When you want to challenge a player:

--you must do it on your turn, before you get your question.

--the player you challenge must already have a game card

-- both of you must also have at least 1 skeleton part of your own in case you lose the challenge!

Place your game card face down in front of the player you want to challenge. The challenged player places one of their playing cards next to yours. Turn both cards over at the same time to see the result.

The player with the highest number wins the challenge (the highest number is 10). The player with the lower number card must put a skeleton part back into the center pile.

If the Challenge is Tied:

If the numbers are the same, it's a draw. If you and the challenged player have enough cards, you can challenge that player a total of three times. Used cards are returned to the bottom of the deck.
